“We Are In This Together”

The following guidelines have been agreed upon by parent(s) and teen regarding the privilege of the use of the family vehicle, or any other vehicle which the teen may drive.

With mutual respect for each other's needs and concerns, we affirm our intentions to honor the conditions of use listed below.

TEEN WILL:

- Drive only when given permission.
- Wear seat belt at all times; and require all passengers to wear theirs.
- Limit the number of passengers to _____.

- Keep doors locked while driving.
- Obey traffic laws and always drive at or below the speed limit, according to road conditions.
- Call parent, or other designated responsible adult, if assistance of any kind is needed.

TEEN WILL NOT:

- Talk on cell phone, text or be distracted by other electronic devices while driving.
- Use vehicle for the purpose of racing or engaging in stunts or thrill-seeking activities.
- Drive when fatigued or stressed.
- Drive under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.
- Allow anyone else to drive the vehicle.
- Conceal any tickets, warnings or collisions.
- Allow the gas tank to go below ¼ of a tank.

TEEN acknowledges that loss of driving privileges and other personal privileges will occur should any of these rules be broken or if school grades fall below an agreed upon level. In the event of a traffic violation, additional sanctions will also occur.

PARENT PLEDGES TO:

- Act as a good role model, partnering with teen to provide the training and on the road experience necessary for teen to become a safe and competent driver.
- Assist teen in a calm and caring, non-judgmental manner, supporting through respectful instruction and feedback.
- Accept a call at any time for a ride or to provide assistance to teen with no questions asked.
